It is technically possible for the recruiting commander of the service you're trying to join to go over MEPS to request a medical waiver from their medical command, but this is rare. Once your medical examination is complete, you are determined to be either "medical qualified for military service," or "medically disqualified for military service," according to the medical standards set by DoD.

How to Get a Medical Waiver to Join the Military

Applying for a Medical Waiver to Join the Military Once you get your 2807-2 back from MEPS and you look through the TDQ (s) or PDQ (s) they gave you, you will need to prepare your case for a medical waiver. Basically, you will need to get a doctor or medical specialist to review each item for which you received a TDQ or PDQ.

In the Air Force system, it is critical to discuss the submission of a waiver package with your medical provider before a medical board is initiated. Once the medical board process is started, a medical waiver will no longer be considered to be an option.
